Every year, the Dutchess County Transportation Council (DCTC) organizes volunteers to count people walking and bicycling at 30-35 locations around the county.

The dates for this year's counts are **Tuesday September 11, Wednesday September 12, and Thursday September 13 (all 4-6 pm; the volunteer chooses which day to count)**, as well as **Saturday, September 15 (12-2 pm)**.

We try to count on 'typical' days -- we can change dates as needed to avoid community events.
